

ABSTRACT

Correction of asymmetric or unfavorable results of breast augmentation is sometimes difficult and understanding the cause of the deformity is mainstay. In this case-oriented presentation of correction of asymmetric breast augmentation, we will discuss about the cause of the deformity: including pocket / surgical plane / implant size and combined problem. A problem-oriented approach will help to clarify the required correction to achieve the best results. Secondary revision or a staged revision is sometimes required. We will also discuss about the indication for stage revision.
